In Körperwelten, the exquisite form and physiology of the human body is illuminated by more than 200 new authentic human specimens that show the latest advances in plastination and dissection technology. The exhibit features original plastinates, never before seen in Brussels, including individual organs, transparent body slices, and whole bodies, transformed through the revolutionary preservation process. See the body in disease, distress and optimal health by comparing smokers and non-smokers lungs, dysfunctional and robust hearts or optimal and over weight bodies. Körperwelten are the only public anatomical presentations with an established Body Donation Programme.

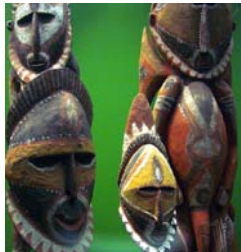
NOCTURNES MUSEUM'S NIGHTS

For centuries, the artists of Oceania created ritual objects and symbols of power that conferred their own identity on the numerous tribes that lived on its territory. These people created an art full of contrasts in order to venerate their gods, their ancestors or the spirits of nature. For the first time in Belgium, two hundred works of art from this mysterious region are exhibited to give a clear and attractive insight into the various cultures of Oceania. A splendid discovery from the most prestigious collections!



THE SMILE OF BUDDHA, 1600 YEARS OF BUDDHIST ART IN KOREA

Within the framework of the Korea Festival in 2008, the Centre for Fine Arts will be showing the finest masterpieces of Buddhist art from the history of Korea. For more than 1,600 years Buddhism has played an important role in Korean society. Among the treasures on display will be a number of "national treasures" from the National Museum in Seoul, including the gilded bronze Maitreya figure from the early 7th century, and a selection of the grandest paintings of the Goryeo period.



COBRA

This exhibition that is organised on the occasion of the 60th anniversary of the birth of the CoBra movement retraces the history of the Cobra movement in its historical and cultural context. This artistic movement that was created in 1948 with artists from Copenhagen, Brussels and Amsterdam is still little known outside Europe. With 150 works the Royal Museums for Fine Arts revisit the movement between 1948 and 1951. See also our special package that we offer with this event.



THAT'S OPERA

The exhibition "That's Opera" provides an insightful and intimate look behind the scenes of the making of an Opera. The exhibition itself is a stage set, allowing the visitor to access the theatre's workshop where scenery, back drops and the larger props are made, as well as the orchestra pit and even the stage. The visitor becomes an active participant in the "making" of a work of art and experiences the way from the first idea to the complete stage production.

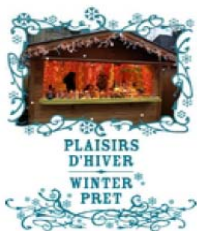


NOCTURNES DU SABLON
